## Covdi-19 Reopening plan

The Arthur Murray Dance studio will reopen May 18, 2020 for Individual Dance Lessons Only

- Hand washing will be required by the teacher and student, before and after your personal dance lesson. This should be done for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water.
- Hand sanitizer will be available however, hand washing is encouraged as the best practice for protection.
- Masks/face covers, will be required while on the lesson. The correct position of the mask will cover both the nose and mouth.
- We will be allowing only 3 teachers to be on the floor at a time to allow for more social distancing and the lessons will be “no touch” lessons, at least for the time being.
- Please bring your own water bottle, we will not have cups sitting out for public use at this time.
- We will be cleaning and sanitizing the most frequently touched surfaces in between each lesson. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets and sinks.
- We will continue to offer online interactive private lessons, group classes and virtual dance parties for anyone concerned about their personal risk going out in public.
- Of course, it should go without saying, but if you are feeling ill or have possibly been exposed to someone with COVID, please do not come into the studio.
